DPI's Have you ...

• Sized your dpi entries correctly: maximum height of 800 pixels – or – max width 1280 pix

(basically do not exceed either measurement – i.e one side is likely to be less than the max unless it is a perfect 1280×800 pixel image.

- Please try to send your images as attached files rather than copied and pasted into the body of your forwarding e-mail (otherwise it does cause additional work)
- Put the title and number** of your image on each file, for example:
 - 01 Golden eagle
 - 02 Hoar frost on berries
 - 03 Rainbow over Caradoc
 - ** numbering helps my filing and randomising of running order.
- Send to Jill Ming, Competition Secretary, at longmyndcameraclub@gmail.com by the end of the Sunday prior to competition.

PRINTS

There is a recognised competition sizing that we like to work to – but just work within this as you can. So, either:

- Print on A4 sized paper (if you are printing at home) or look for something like 12 x 8 or 10 x 8 inches if printing commercially. Anything smaller will look disappointing compared to other entries
 - or, even better print up to A3 size
- Once you have your print, it should be mounted on card** (either stick on, or through a
 window mount). I suggest you have a border of maybe 1.5 to 2.5 inches. Maximum mount
 size is 500mm x 400mm.
- Print titles need to be sent to Jill Ming together with your dpi's. Bring the prints to the meeting with the title and your member number clearly written on the back.

^{**} Pre-cut mountboard for this purpose is commercially available (e.g. Paper Spectrum, among others).
